### How we're keeping you safe

- **Conference Venues & ASA Safety Planning:** Each of our event venues are registered COVID-Safe. The ASA is working in conjunction with them on the delivery of COVID-Safe events.
- **Communication:** Information about health and safety at events will be regularly distributed to all stakeholders via the event website and email communications.
- **Hand sanitiser** made available throughout the venues
- **Discouraging handshakes** to support social distancing
- **Encouraging facemasks** throughout the venues, in line with state and territory requirements
- **Event capacity limits** in place
- **Closely monitoring** the circumstances in every state and territory
- **Proof of vaccination** may be required at venues in accordance with state and territory guidelines
